

Since 1984 the Smith family have been growing quality grapes on their Claylaur Family Estate vineyards. The fruit for this wine is from two diverse quality sites, the glacial out wash gravels of the southern Omaka Valley and the stony silt soil of the central Wairau Valley.

The outstanding 2009 vintage has produced a wine of exceptional varietal character for which Marlborough is renown; citrus, gooseberry and dried herb aromas support a palate of great intensity, richness

and length that are all hallmarks of this famous region. Enjoy.
